Ardentinny Community Council News

Car Park Toilet Block

Pleased to say that the toilets are open. Argyll and Bute Council have repaired the leak, but there is still a problem with the electrics (which are tripping). They have logged this and will send out someone to fix it. They will also repair the broken lock in the cupboard.

Ardentinny Community Council Resident Survey;

Operational update from <u>Forestry and Land Scotland</u> covering upcoming works and events for Ardentinny CC area;

The back sections of our car park is closed off due to unsafe branches hung up in the trees above the track, these will be addressed as soon as the team have capacity.

Also the Toilets are currently offline as there was a blockage in the water supply which was preventing water getting to the toilets, we have resolved the issue but are just allowing the main tank to refill and then a change of filters will allow us to reopen next week.

We are still working on solutions for the bin issues over peak time in the summer to prevent the build up of litter next summer.

We are still working on planning permission for the road improvements at Ardentinny, we will update you before any works are due to start.

Village Roads

We (Ardentinny Community Council) have logged two areas of potholes in the village online with Argyll and Bute Council. They have replied with an estimated completion date of 18 Feb 2023, but they may have done it today!
