
# Scams – just for your information, regrettably people will try anything these days!

# The following information is being circulated on behalf of Police Scotland

Police Scotland has seen a rise in scammers impersonating police officers. Below you will find advice on checking an officer's identity.

If Police Scotland contact you, they will do so in person, by phone or by email. This will depend on the circumstances surrounding why they need to contact you.

#### Contact in person.

If an officer contacts you in person, they'll show you their police warrant card. This is proof of their identity and authority, and you can verify this by dialling 101.

#### Contact by phone and Email

If an officer needs to speak to you on the phone or by email, they'll identify themselves clearly.

#### They will never:

- · ask you for your bank details or PIN
- ask you to transfer funds to another account
- ask you to hand over cash or bank cards to a courier
- ask you to pay a fine or a fee to them or a third party over the phone or online
- ask you for remote access to your computer, passwords or log on details over the phone or online
- ask you to register personal details in an attachment they send or website they direct towards
- ask you to 'assist' in an investigation by doing any of the above
- · communicate in an abusive, threatening or coercive manner
- ask you to click on a hyperlink to participate in an investigation

Remember if you're unsure about whether the person you're dealing with is a genuine police officer – stop – and call 101 to check their identity. You should also contact 101 if you think you've been a victim of fraud.





This week, we have seen an increase in people cold-calling, that is, knocking on doors of properties without an appointment, and offering work such as gardening, fixing driveways, cleaning roofs or fixing gutters. Reports received have been from the Isle of Bute, Rhu and Lochgair.

This week alone, we have various reports throughout Argyll and Bute, including island communities. Some of these reports have linked back to people involved in rogue trading throughout Scotland. Don't be caught out.

Not everyone that cold-calls is committing a crime. However, we do not support cold calling as there is a high chance that the work ends up being of a poor standard, you may be overcharged, and as we have seen in some cases, you have money taken, and no work is done at all.

Please do not risk becoming a victim of cold-callers:




Only agree to any work once you have several quotes from reputable companies.



Research all companies - obtain their full business details (address, phone number).



Obtain a written contract of what you have agreed regarding the work and the price.



Don't feel you have to rush in because they are at your door now - take time and keep

If you think you have been the victim of doorstep crime or are fearful for your safety due to a cold-caller,



call Police Scotland on 999 (emergency) or 101 (non-emergency). If you are making



a retrospective report, you can also do this online
