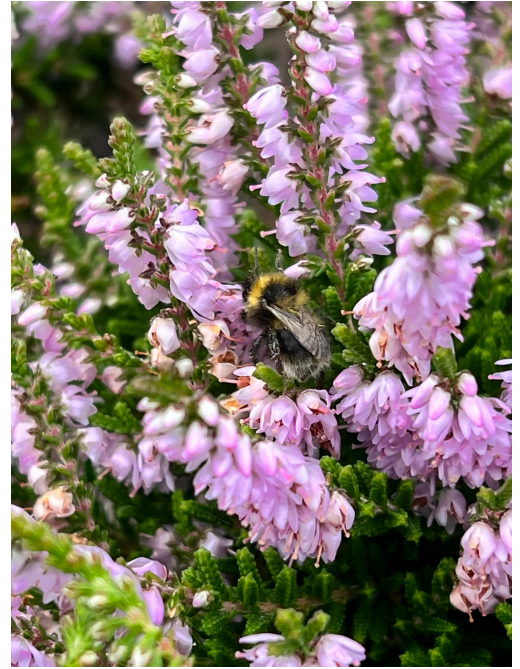

Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) Update

We received the following update from FLS regarding the forests in our community council area;

- Site has been busy during the holidays and nicer weather days;
- Bins have needed some additional collections organised but Argyll & Bute Council have been able to action this quickly for us;
- There has been some issues with the toilets, but we are working with our building team to resolve;
- Following consultation with Argyll & Bute Council we have removed our blue/green algae warning notices from site;
- There will be forest road upgrades starting in the block above the village soon.

HMNB Clyde Meeting
