At the recent Community Council public Meeting, one of the concerns raised was the status of the Dunoon Library, we received this update from them which are sharing below;



"Dunoon Library is pleased to announce its reopening on Tuesday 11th March, at 9:30 AM. The main library is now situated on the ground floor of the Queen's Hall, providing full accessibility for all members and visitors.

Our dedicated Children's section has been relocated to the upper ground floor, adjacent to the new takeaway café. This area boasts an extensive selection of Fiction and Non-Fiction books with a comfortable space for children to enjoy reading and activities.

We are pleased to inform you that starting Tuesday 18th March, you can access our full People's Network Computers during unstaffed hours. During staffed hours, our library team members will be available to assist you, while during unstaffed hours, you can conveniently access the computers at our self-service kiosk located in the reception area of the Queen's Hall. Bookbug sessions will continue every Thursday and Friday at 11 am in the entertainment area on the third floor. From this Thursday, 13th March, we warmly invite families with children aged 0 to 5 years to join us, sharing stories, songs and rhymes.

HALL CLOSURE – NEW TRUSTEES NEEDED URGENTLY

The hall currently has 4 Trustees however 3 Trustees will be standing down at the next AGM. The AGM will be held on Tuesday 6th May 2025. The hall constitution requires a minimum of 3 Trustees for a quorum, it cannot legally continue with only 1 Trustee remaining. In the event of no new Trustees coming forward *then the hall will be forced to close and the property sold*. Surplus funds would then be transferred to other charitable bodies.

If the hall is lost it is highly unlikely that we would manage to get it replaced. It's a fantastic facility for the village as well as being the emergency hub for the community.

Please, please if you are a regular (or occasional) hall Member or user consider 'standing in the gap' for a season so that we can retain the hall for current and future users.
