Beach Issues

As mentioned last week, there were reports of dogs becoming seriously ill after visiting the beach, possibly due to blue/green algae in the water or perhaps the presence of Hemlock Water Dropwort. It is still a bit unclear as to what is behind the illnesses.

We informed Forestry and Land Scotland and they have put up warning signs of the potential risks of the Hemlock, which is appreciated.

Ardentinny Community Emergency Plan Update Information

We have been able to get back in contact with the MOD at Faslane/Coulport. We have wanted a way to contact the Police boats and Rhibs that are on Loch Long in case of an emergency in the water around Ardentinny. So we now we have the contact number for the Control room which can be called for an emergency;

Coulport control room - 01436 674321 select option 2 and then extension 6429. Alternatively, Clyde Control Room 01436 674321 Option 1 extension 7339 will provide contact with the Operational control room and be able to direct the police assets and support.

Ardentinny Village Hall News

Hi Everyone,

Two brand new BBQ's and 2 gazebos have now been delivered which will make organising events and outside functions more achievable.

These are also available for the village to use for a donation to the village hall. A set of guidelines for using these will be explained to anyone who is interested and will be posted on the notice board in the hall once these have been written up.

You may be pleased to know, there has been outside interest from people wishing to book the hall for personal events as word is getting out there about the upgrades and improvements. This is all positive and will help towards raising funds for the hall which will benefit everyone.

Completed

All lighting and electrical work has now been completed apart from a cooker socket which there is no rush for at the moment. Thank you to our local electrician Harry for working all hours on his days off and between other jobs. Instead of an immersion heater, there is now instant hot water which makes things easier for holding any events which were mentioned above as well as our regular users.

The old water tank which has been removed, is plastic and we are hoping to recycle this for storing grit, sand, and salt for the roads in winter.

As the hall is now watertight, the window to the right of the hall has now been plastered and the supports removed. Thank you to Guy Elder for this.

Still to be completed

Future works include the installation of internet facility's this is not part of this fund and the hall has raised the capital to fund this installation which we hope will be up and running shortly just waiting on the BT engineers to do their bit and we are currently putting the pressure on for this to be completed sooner rather than later as this has taken far longer than it should.

Going forward we do have plans to refurbish and re-instate the kitchen area so we can once again look to use this facility and once a fund has been found we will look to renew the heating system in the hall.

Anyone who would still like to pay membership fees, can do this by posting in the letter box attached to the hall. Other options are to call at Angle Cottage or Rock Cottage with their payment. Thank you.

We currently have 4 volunteers to clean the hall on a rota basis. Thank you, this is very much appreciated. After speaking with the CC at the meeting on 6th June, we are still looking at other options. Updates to follow once we know more.
