#### **Ardentinny Picnic Site**

We received the following update from Forestry and Land Scotland regarding the Ardentinny picnic site –

Low fencing installation is planned for some of the grass areas to stop car parking.

Water Borehole at the Toilet Block – Their contractors will be on site soon to connect up the new supply, this is planned to replace the current water supply from the hill. The new water supply should be in place for the summer season.

There is a National Park ‘day of action’ planned for Ardentinny for July 11<sup>th</sup> which will be a mix of National Park Ranger service, FLS, Police Scotland and possibly SFRS focussing on visitor engagement, responsible behaviour, water and fire safety.

Some minor road repairs have been undertaken but further work is planned.
