The parish has three community automated defibrillators. They are sited at The Rodney Stoke Inn, The Strawberry Special and Draycott Memorial Hall. Key-fobs with the defibrillator cabinet access code, **C123X**, are available from the Draycott Community Shop. In the event of an incident:

1. **Dial 999** and call for an ambulance. 2. **Start CPR** (chest compressions) 3. If a second person is available **send THEM** for the defibrillator - **do NOT stop CPR**.
