Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2)
(21 Day Notice)
The Street, Rodney Stoke
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along:

The Street - from 34 metres north-east of the junction with Station Road, north-eastwards for a total distance of **103 metres**

This Notice will come into operation on the **21st June 2025** and will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period Somerset Council may issue a further 21 day Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **21st June 2025** and last until **24th June 2025** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **4 days**.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to replace chamber**.
