Receipts & Payments ...

Our receipts have risen slightly in line with our increasing membership numbers, but our payments have increased more significantly – mainly due to the purchase of a new Sound System and IT equipment for Trustees' use.

Reserves ...

Our Reserves are more than adequate for our current needs and can be allowed to fall.



Comments ...

Annual Subscription...

Although our Reserves remain healthy, 2024-25 saw us incur an operating deficit of 85p per member.

It is anticipated that another deficit will be incurred in 2025-26, as TAT subscriptions and other prices increase. This will be covered by drawing on the surplus in our Current account.

Looking ahead, the Trustees are proposing to increase subscriptions for 2026-27 by £1 per member, while continuing to use our surplus funds to cover any shortfall.




