5 Parish Group

The 5 Parish group of A453 Parish Councils continue to meet and pool expertise to discuss and respond to the wider development proposals around the power station, A453 and greenbelt that will affect all our villages.

- We have recently seen 3 different planning applications for large battery storage sites on different locations on green belt land along the A453 corridor. One on Nottingham road, that has already been refused, but is planning an appeal. The other two are on Kegworth Road, Ratcliffe and land off West Leake Lane/ A453.
- We have been notified that the company behind the solar farm proposals at Gotham/ West Leake hills (misleadingly called Kingston solar farm) are planning an appeal after their planning application was rejected.
- We are monitoring proposals for Gypsum extraction on Wright's Hill at the Power Station. There will be a knock on traffic impact of this from additional HGV's transporting gypsum to East Leake via West Leake Lane and the New Kingston crossroads. The increased transport is within previously permitted limits.
- There is a National consultation out on Government proposals to amend how Local Plans are developed and proposals to increase the frequency of review.
- Uniper (who own the power station) has outlined its plans to produce low carbon hydrogen, using electrolysis technology, once the power station has stopped generating at the end of September 2024.

Kingston Harvest Festival

The harvest festival, a celebratory service with more singing, poetry and readings than prayer, will take place in Kingston Church on **Sunday 1st October at 5.00pm**. It is called harvest festival for historic reasons, but you can also regard it as a thanksgiving service for the end of the gardening year. The service will be a traditional harvest festival with gifts of produce and other items, which will be donated to the South Notts Foodbank. The church is listed in the best 1,000 churches in England because of its beautiful stonework and carvings, so if you have never been inside Kingston Church before please come in to appreciate the beauty of our village church.

The service will be followed by harvest supper in the village hall at 6.30pm – please contact Angie on 07855 989271 or angiecraft@hotmail.co.uk by 24th September if you would like to come to the supper to help us cater for the right number.

The church tower will be open between 6.00pm and 6.30pm for anybody who wants to climb up it for the impressive view from the top.

The Open Gardens event in June 2023 raised a wonderful £7,020 for Cancer Research UK.



Just a reminder to anyone who hasn't yet used the Nottsbus On Demand. Nottsbus is a new flexible way to travel by bus - simply book your journey using the Nottsbus On Demand App.

The **West Rushcliffe Zone service** (which includes Kingston on Soar). It can take you to the major transport hubs of Clifton tram stop; East Midlands Airport and East Midlands Parkway in addition to all local stops in the villages highlighted on the map below. All for just £2 per ride.

Nottsbus On Demand services do not follow a fixed timetable. Instead, they operate on a flexible, on demand basis.
