2.	Mackintosh Centre – currently full for residents, with respite bed booked until end November. Still seeking additional staff before daycare can re-commence
3.	<b>Burial Ground</b> – Still no update from HC despite many attempts to move things forward/ascertain current thinking. Cllr Saggers to contact David Lamont for update
4.	Local Place Plan – No progress has been made over the summer – however Tiina Heinonen is taking the lead moving forward and is to be contacted for update and clarification of what thinking now is
5.	Meeting Updates:  A.C.T. – Meeting to discuss Gower Trust process and approvals to be held w/c 22 Sept.  B8008 – Next meeting w/c 20 Oct  RTIFG – Next meeting w/c 29 Sept  Lochaber Health and Social Care – no update
6.	Gower Trust Approvals  No applications outstanding. Application submitted by ADCC for next round of funding to cover defibrillator costs.  Meeting agreed to ask Gower Trust for funds to help with ADCC costs
7.	Reports: Treasurer – Balance currently £934.58. Still running at slight deficit – it is hoped that Gower Trust application will be positively received Police – no update. Moving forward, police report to be at top of agenda to make attendance simpler
8.	Planning Applications – nothing of concern.
9.	AOCB Resilience Plan – no progress over summer. Meeting to be held to progress asap
	Visitor Levy – No update – likely to be discussed a next HC meeting
	Defibrillator expenses – defibrillator at LSIC needs new pads
	<b>Dog Waste Bins</b> – ad to be put in Westword and on village whatsapp groups to see if anyone comes forward to help with this
	<b>Village Benches</b> - bench by the rope swings down the Rhu road needs to be assessed for safety and probably removed as it is in a state of disrepair. Will be repaired or replaced as and when funds are available
	Roads — Old Road Speed Limit — roads dept advised that the road between Dunollie and 30mph limit does not meet criteria for reduced limit. Trying to ascertain what those criteria are Roads dept to be contacted to ask about clearing ditches between Arisaig surgery and Tigh Beithe and opposite
	Morroch, and pruning trees encroaching on road at first cattle grid on Rhu road
	Bonfire Night – New PEL applied for and follow up paperwork in progress.
