	Village Benches - bench by the rope swings down the Rhu road needs to be assessed for safety and probably removed as it is in a state of disrepair. Will be repaired or replaced as and when funds are available
	Roads — Old Road Speed Limit — roads dept advised that the road between Dunollie and 30mph limit does not meet criteria for reduced limit. Trying to ascertain what those criteria are Roads dept to be re-contacted to ask about clearing ditches between Arisaig surgery and Tigh Beithe and opposite Morroch, and pruning trees encroaching on road at first cattle grid on Rhu road
	Bonfire Night – PEL granted. Organisation in hand
