Professional knowledge of emergency procedures.

Local leaders:

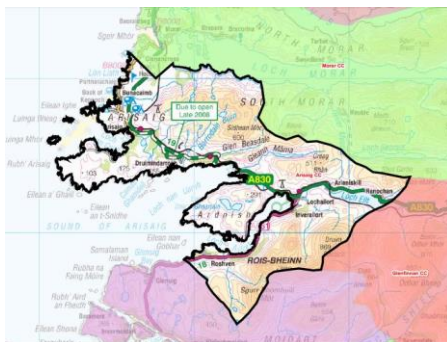
Community figures who can mobilize support and provide direction.

Voluntary organizations:

Local groups or charities that have existing networks and resources.

Statutory agencies:

Representatives from local government, police, fire, and health services who can coordinate with official responders.

KEY ROLES & PERSPECTIVES

Local knowledge:

Residents who know the area's unique risks, history, and vulnerable spots.

Communication skills:

People who can help create clear and effective communication plans for emergencies.

Health and social care:

Individuals who understand the community's health needs and can assist vulnerable residents.

Resource management:

Those who can identify and organize local resources, from physical assets to skills.

YOU, YOU AND YOU!

Technical experts:

Depending on the community's risks, this could include engineers, IT specialists, utility workers, or other professionals.

Mental health and social cohesion:

Individuals who can help build strong social connections and support the community's mental well-being through difficult times.

People from different geographical areas within the Community:

Our community is spread out over large geographical area, so we need volunteers from each smaller area.

People with things that could be useful in an emergency:

E.g. Tractors, Diggers, IT resources, Communication devices, Generators, Drones, Superpowers
