- Edge straightening and further roads work at RAF Machrihanish, Campbeltown to Peninver and some at Drumlemble. Also the road area at the Peugeot Garage but this is Bear Scotland and has been postponed. Drainage and improper footway to also be looked at. Aqualibrium Avenue is causing problems with crossing the road. There is to be a consultation to which as many as possible should attend.
