2. Update on Actions from Last Minutes

- **SSEN compensation.** SSEN have awarded £500 to the Southend Community Council in compensation for the power outage during Storm Eowyn. £250 of this will go to Dunaverty Hall for fuel for the Generator; proposer JU, seconded by CC.

- The Capital Roads programme has commenced in earnest the Southend road has already seen some patchwork, with more to follow.
- The Kidney Dialysis Unit and the temporary reduction in beds in Campbeltown Hospital will be reviewed at the next Strategic Review mtg on 11 June.
- The Victoria Hall has been awarded a grant to enable the renovation of the front of the building.

- **High Dalrioch Wind Farm proposal**. After careful consideration of the results of early site investigation and wind monitoring, SSE have decided not to proceed with further development of the site. This is due to various constraints on site and with the project.
- Machrihanish 40mph speed limit. As of 14th July 2025, there will be a 40mph Limit on B843 on that length of the Route B843 Machrihanish Road, from a point 1045 metres or thereby east of the extended west kerbline of the Isleview Housing Scheme Road (Machrihanish) in an easterly direction for a distance of 620 metres or thereby.
