**Stones on roadside verges** Cllr Powell questioned the safety and legality of the placing of these stones outside properties along Old Coach Road, Clerk will query with SDC.



Note to Parish Councillors

FREE RESOURCE

Under the Local Government Act 1963 extended by the Local Government Act 1972 a Parish Council may spend in every year up to (currently) £3.50 per elector (1995/6 465 x £3.50 = £1627.50) on anything which in the opinion of the Parish Council is in the interests of the Parish or all or some of the inhabitants. This includes contributions to a charitable body or any body providing a public service otherwise than for gain in the U.K.
