

Bonfire night was a positive outcome with officers disrupting large groups of youths prior to them committing any offences. No major issues reported or noted across the Abergavenny, Mardy, Llanfoist and Llanelly Hill areas.

Current ASB issues and areas:

The main current ASB issue we are facing within the Abergavenny area is Shoplifts from local stores within the town centre leading up to Christmas we tend to see an increase.

We have had another increase of begging on the town centre. We are currently trying to tackle this issue leading up to Christmas.

Over the past month we have had issues with youths stealing eggs from the supermarkets and throwing them at people's property, we are currently dealing with these youths.

Our current ASB Hotspots are Abergavenny town and shops, Bailey Park, and Morrisons and Esso garage.

We have had an increase of burglaries from the car sales within the Abergavenny area, two males have been bailed and are being investigated. We have spoken to all garages and given the relative safety advice.

Current safety advice-

We have seen some instances of a male masturbating and exposing himself near to the canal in Llanfoist and Gilwern. Please advise people to be cautions and to gather any evidence they can to assist us in identifying potential offenders. – A male has been arrested and the investigation is still ongoing.

All Stores have been spoken to with regards to their alcohol and are to be moved from the front entrance of the stores to a secure location.

There has still been and increase with theft of eggs from the supermarkets, we are currently speaking with the store to prevent the youth's stealing eggs.

Advice has been given directly to car sales in Abergavenny regarding the current breaks.

Good Work Section

- A few engagement events at Abergavenny Market highlighting ASB issues and knife crime.
- Plain clothes operations for shoplifting have taken place, a male was dealt with for carrying a bladed article in the town centre.
- Two warrants were executed at an address in Abergavenny.
- A regular shoplifter in the Abergavenny area has been arrested.
- A number of strike letters have been delivered to the Torfaen youths for their behaviour when attending Abergavenny.
- Christmas light switch on preceded without any issues.
- An input was taken place in Llanfoist primary school with yr 5-6 regarding ASB after school time.
