2. Police Report for January 2025

The Police report was presented by PC Joshua Carey and detailed matters including anti-social behaviour and recovery of stolen goods

3. Minutes of the Meeting Held on 15th January

4. Matters Arising

Page 1, Minute 3: Councillor Hayward stated in respect of the new Health and Safety procedures that emergency lighting and fire alarms were on order and a record would be kept in a log book that had been set up.

9. Playing Fields and Green Spaces

Details had been received from Zoe Cameron (Mardy Roots) of an opportunity to enhance the current 'Places for Nature' planting scheme in Mardy Fields by purchasing an ornamental cherry tree costing £46.86 and a plum tree for £20. Tidying up work and replanting the raised planters near the Hall would also benefit the area and could be carried out at a small cost to the Council. The proposals were approved.

It was also suggested by Ms Cameron that Llantilio Pertholey Community Council should join 'Abergavenny in Bloom' which was also approved.

10. Community Hall Matters

- 1) Following a recording failure of the Council's CCTV system an engineer had been called in and the system's hard drive replaced and is once more in full working order.
- 2) Repairs were needed to the Hall's projection system and quotes have been received including one from Vision at a cost of £1650 plus VAT which was approved.
