

Booking Info for the Mardy Community Hall

- To book the Hall please ring Bethan Pearson tel: 07961 120 063 or send an email to bethanpearson123@icloud.com
- The Village Hall also has a facebook page namely <https://www.facebook.com/LlantiliocommunityhallMardy>
- Available from as early as 6am until as late as 11pm every day of the week
- The hourly hire charge for the main hall is £15 and just £7 for the far smaller meeting rooms. Each have a projector, screen, chairs and tables
- Before using one of our projectors for the first time you should ask either Bethan or Mike to demonstrate the setup beforehand. The projectors (NEC M230X and NEC UM330W) accommodate an HDMI or VGA input. Unfortunately there is no Bluetooth (wireless) facility. When using an iPad, for perhaps a 'slide' presentation, you will need a 'lightning to HDMI' adaptor, and an Android tablet that supports 'HDMI Alt Mode' would need an 'USB-C to HDMI' adaptor
- The access keys for regular groups are collected from a key safe up to 15 minutes before the booking and should be returned within 15 minutes afterwards. For 'party' bookings or a one-off group meeting Bethan will be there to open the Hall around 10 minutes beforehand and will secure the Hall at the end of the reservation. The heating is regulated remotely by our Caretaker
- You must be prepared to pay by cash or with a cheque when given access to the Hall although regular group bookings are invoiced by our Clerk, Mr Robert Wade
- There is a kitchen with cooking facilities namely a traditional oven, a microwave, a hot water urn and a fridge. Plates, glasses, jugs, cups, saucers and cutlery are provided
- There is no refuse facility and you are expected to take your rubbish, including food waste, home with you. And please leave the Hall as found with tables and chairs put away tidily
- The toilets include disabled access and a baby changing facility
- There are no shared sports equipment: you are expected to bring your own
- The Hall OS and postal code addresses are SO 30641 15615 and NP7 6HF. When travelling in a northerly direction along the Hereford Road to the Mardy you turn left just after the brow of the hill into Llwynu Lane, take the 2nd right into St Teilo's Road and then the 3rd right into St David's Close. Situated alongside the Welsh Medium School and has a dedicated, relatively small, car-park. And behind the Hall is the Mardy Park football ground and a childrens' playground
