

DORNOCH 500

RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Dornoch 500 is to raise funds. Any money raised will be paid into the DADCA bank account and used to help fund our bonfire night and Hogmanay street parties, and maintain our community facility.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of £25 per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 500.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize, and 4 runners up prizes.
- 3. All 500 numbers will be in the draw participants understand they have a 1 in 500 chance of winning.
- 4. The Dornoch 500 is a small society lottery and is open to all. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 5. Numbers are limited to five per household.
- 6. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual payment. One month's notice is requested for cancellation.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be valid if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 9. The draw shall be made by the Committee on the advertised dates.
- 10. Winners will be contacted within one week of the draw and asked for payment details.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on our facebook page, on our webpage and at the Dornoch service point.
- 12. The Dornoch 500 lottery will be run by the DADCA Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
- 13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Dornoch 500 if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into DADCA funds after six months.
