## CHAPELHILL PARISH CHURCH GRAVEYARD & LOGIEALMOND GRAVEYARD

The graveyard at Chapelhill is a rectangular raised platform on the northern edge of the valley which falls 50 metres to the river Almond, 12 kms northwest of Perth. It is accessible from Chapelhill Hall, situated on the old east-west route, now bypassed by the B8063 to the north. It contains a small barrel vaulted building (last used for the heating plant), the demolished remains of the church, and formerly, a watch-house of 1833 by the gate. The new cemetery lies 200 metres northeast.

This church is probably on the site of a Pre-Reformation chapel, and was rebuilt in 1643 and in 1834. The graveyard was the sole burial place in Logicalmond until the opening of the cemetery in the 1920s. From the Reformation the district was divided at various times between the parishes of Fowlis Wester, Moneydie, Monzie, Redgorton, plus Crieff and Methven. The Chapelhill kirk became the Quoad sacra Parish church of Logicalmond in 1854, and the Civil parish was created in 1890 with the name Monzie, renamed Logicalmond in 1895.

But for two centuries many of those interred at Chapelhill were adherents of other churches in the district- the Secession kirk on the drovers stance at Kendrum, later at the west end of Harrietfield, and the Free Kirk at the northwest corner of Harrietfield, which continued as the Parish church after the union of 1929 and the closure of Chapelhill Kirk .in the 1950s. The church history is described in "Logiealmond" by D.M.Forrester, (1944), which drew on Thomas Wylie's "Recollections and Traditions chiefly of Logiealmond' (1884-1932), both available in the A.K.BellLibrary, Perth. Wylie's Second series (1932) contains a list of inhabitants of over 18yrs of Logiealmond subscribing for the watch house in 1833, a total of 185 names, with occupation and residence.

Thomas Wylie records some interesting stories on the lives of Logiealmond residents in his lifetime and tales that had been passed on to him. Of the kirkyard at Chapelhill he surmises that many flat stones had sunk below the turf and were covered over in time. The uneven ground between the standing stones testify to this. The graveyard is small, half of it being taken over by the ruins of the church and the small doorless building, stone flagged whose exterior roof is made of concrete.

To the left of the gate stands a tall obelisk to the Rev. Alexander Young, erected by his parishioners for his faithful ministry of sixty- five years. At the bottom, almost as an afterthought is inscribed the name of the Rev. Alexander Preston the minister who preceded Mr Young and who died in 1909. When the grave was being prepared, the diggers found a large flat stone under the surface dated 1680 to Stephen Ireland, the Warlock of Milnhole.

In their time the Irelands of Milnhole were avoided by the locals and described as being "a pestilent family". The male members all possessed great strength and Stephen, in a time of much superstition and fear of the supernatural, was thought to have magical powers.

Once he "charmed" rats from his meal bags, causing them to fight and kill each other until the last rat was left. Another time he demanded that his tenants help him to "stretch" a tree trunk. While the men pulled at one end he stood at the end tied by a rope. Asking the men to give an extra hard pull he cut the the rope with an axe and they all rolled down a slope into the Shochie burn. What the grave digger did with his stone and why a "warlock" was allowed into consecrated ground is a mystery.

Another interesting stone is propped against the church wall. It once stood just inside the gates. The wording is simple LIZZIE - "in no wise cast out". Taken from John 6. 37 the full text

reads "All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out". What had Lizzie done in life to ask for such salvation?

The gravestones in Chapelhill are predominantly simple headstones with little design or carving. An exception is the Adam and Eve stone. It depicts Adam and Eve on either side of the Tree of Life. According to Dane Love in "Scottish Graveyards", of the forty-five of this type in Scotland, fifteen are to be found in Perthshire. Variation are found in Eve reaching up to pick the apple or holding it in her hand. The serpent is coiled round the trunk of the tree. Adam and Eve stones go back to early Christianity and an 8th century stone can be seen at Iona. Adam and Eve share the side of this stone with carvings of a share and coulter, the farmers tools, and the skull, bones and skull, symbols of mortality.

When members of the Genealogy Society recorded pre-1885 gravestone in Chapelhill they described the smaller stone building as the Drummond Family Mausoleum. The last of the Drummonds, two unmarried sisters of the estate owner who sold the land to the Earl of Mansfield, were buried in the mausoleum. No inscription marks their passing.

An attractive avenue between hedges leads up to Logiealmond Cemetery which was opened in the 1920's. One hundred and three gravestones have been recorded and of these some names have continued from the old kirk- yard; generations bearing the family name and living in the same place in which their forefathers lived and died. Thestone are generally smaller with the exception of the memorial erected to the Rev. McOuat and his wife. He ministered to Logiealmond people for thirty- five years. He was loved by his congregation for his kindness and compassion. He owned a car and he used it to takes his parishioners to the doctor and to the hospital. So often was the car used for this purpose that according to Wylie one resident ,chatting to a neighbour and seeing the minister's car said, "Whaur's the ambulance gaun the day?". The clergyman was described as being "a bodie's body". Surely that says it all.
