

Acknowledgements

These records have been greatly assisted by the earlier list of pre-1855 monumental inscriptions in North Perthshire which was made in 1975 by John and Sheila Mitchell and others for publication by the Scottish Genealogy Society; a revised edition of this list was edited by Alison Mitchell and published by the Society in 1997.

Kinclaven Church

The present Church stands on the site of at least one previous Church building, and dates from 1848 when it was re-built.

The Minister of the Parish during the re-building was the Reverend Thomas Henderson, DD., whose son Hendry, born in 1840, pioneered the Church of Scotland "Missions in Blantyre, East Africa".

The Church bell is much older, inscribed as follows: "Sole Deo Gloria Burger Huys me fecit. Johanne Young in Tuechit Hillokis gifted me to the Kirk of Kinclaven in September 1656". This old bell, believed to be of Flemish origin, has long been recognised as one of the clearest toned bells in the area.

In the 1730-40s Kinclaven Parish, like many others, had been rent asunder by the Secession. The Minister at that time, the Rev. James Fisher, led about half the congregation from the church and for some two years they held their services in the woods and fields, until granted a piece of land' to build a church, which was known as the Kirk o' the Muir'.

In 1938 The Kirk o' the Muir was re-united with Kinclaven Church.

On 9th October 1955, a date still remembered by older members of the congregation, the Royal Family honoured Kinclaven Church with a visit to morning worship. The Minister, the Reverend Dr. David Scott, DD., conducted the service to a capacity congregation.

In the 1960s the Church was re-slated, re-pointed, re-painted and carpeted. This improvement was continued in 1970, when electricity was brought to the Church, enabling the old coal-fired boiler to be replaced by the present oil-fired system.

CHURCH FURNITURE

The Communion Table was gifted in 1934 by Dr. Andrew G. Reekie and his sister Florinda in memory of their parents - the Reverend Henry Reekie being Minister at Kinclaven from 1883 to 1929.

The Communion Chairs were gifted by John Cree in memory of his parents' long association with Kinclaven. The Livingstone Chorister Organ was purchased by public subscription in 1973.

The Lectern is dedicated to the Glory of God and in memory of Mrs. F. G. Burgess and her friend and companion Mrs. H. Young, 1982.

The Book of Remembrance & Cabinet were gifted by Mrs. Jane Smith, Stanley, in 1987, as was the new carpeting throughout the Church.

In 1986 a Memorial Stained Glass Window in the Church Porch, commemorating for Dr. A.G. Reekie and his grandson, was gifted by his son. All the Church windows are now of stained glass.

The Bishop of Brechin's tomb is incorporated in the retaining wall of the churchyard and can be viewed from the churchyard extension.
