

# Pitcairn and St Serf 's Graveyards

Pitcairn means the cairn of the graves and a sizeable cairn of Pictish times is situated on wooded land, once moor, visible from the Redgorton to Pitcairngreen road.

Legend has it that there were Roman encampments near the farms of Cairnton and Bamblair. The cairn was reputedly built over the graves of local warrior chiefs who died in the battles fought in that area. The name Pitcairn, pit being a grave, was given also to the surrounding land and is found in the names Pitcairnfield and Pitcairngreen.

Pitcairn graveyard is sited on College Mill Road, Bridgeton near the River Almond The burial ground is on the site of St. Serf 's Church. Records show its existence in the 13th Century. It fell into disuse but was restored in the early 16th century by Bishop Brown, one of a line of Dunkeld Bishops.

Crossing the fast-flowing River Almond had always been a problem since no bridge existed and when an infant child from Ruthven Castle (Huntingtower) was drowned when brought to be baptised, the congregation on the south side of the river thereafter worshipped in St Mary's Church, Tibbermore.

In 1614, after the Reformation, the parish boundaries were changed and St Serf's and the churches at Luncarty and Redgorton were joined, with Redgorton becoming the main parish church. The churches at Luncarty and St Serf's were allowed to become ruinous. The site of St. Serf's is indicated on the Ordnance Survey map of 1860.


The inscriptions of pre-1855 headstones were first recorded in 1973 by members of The Scottish Genealogy Society and the recorders noted that "the burial ground was utterly neglected and seemed to be used as a rubbish dump" The 1996 review by that Society described the graveyard as "mown and neat but with the foundations of a new bungalow heaped at the north east end".

Careful removal of debris from four flat stones revealed them to be from the 17th Century with the earliest legible stone dated 1636. These ancient gravestones do not appear in records and their details have been sent to The Carved Stones Advisor of The Council for Scottish Archaeology to be included in the National Records.

Ivy has completely covered several displaced stones which had been set against the south wall. One headstone has been hidden by a holly bush but details of the inscriptions have been recorded. Several of the stones are illegible due to heavy growths of crustaceous lichen.

In 1891 Pitcairn graveyard was closed on the instructions of the County Council and a new burial site was laid out on land granted by David Smythe of Methven Castle. It was named St Serf's Cemetery and was situated on the other side of the river at Lochty, Almondbank. Preparation of the graveyard had taken some time as a date on the wall reads 19.1.88. Neither the lair plan nor the burial book are held at the Council Offices in Pullar House but they were held at one time in Almondbank Post Office and are referred to in a letter from the Committee of Management for St Serf's Cemetery to a local councillor in 1939. At that time all the lairs had been sold.

Some family stones have inscriptions that pre-date the laying out of the cemetery. Two stones are face down.




Entrance to Pitcairn graveyard


The present St Serf 's Church holds its Centenary in 2005.



"Meet me there"






