Proposal: Demolition of existing buildings and the erection of a new

convenience store, with car parking and delivery provisions.

Matters discussed included: Consultee comments; public comments – safe crossing for residents; all areas allocated for parking including the gravel overspill and residential area flow of 13,000 vehicles in one day, parking for 2 retail outlets; ingress and egress; D24 pollution impacts and D25 residential amenity eg control of hours of activity eg deliveries and moving cages and pallets and reversing alarms; control of noise and disturbance eg from refrigeration and air conditioning units; lighting scheme - illuminate site; strategic priority 8 and S2 and S4 and CO1 the convenience store, local access, the need for car travel, provision of a safe crossing and pedestrian/cycle access D2 building should be conducive to walking and cycling. D13 sustainable transport and movement – enhance the facilities for pedestrians and cyclists and other users and enhance road and personal safety. D14 transport impacts access and nature and volume of traffic. Policy D35 seeks to prevent the loss of a facility to the local community, accessible facility for the local community, range of safe sustainable transport modes, other local shops, concern over crime, size of site, volume of traffic parking, potential impact of other unit, spaces for 7 staff and residents and other unit, slanted and straight spaces, no objection to convenience store in principle, safety on A38 and queuing, wide access and left turn, right turn, public transport – staff and visitors,

size of site, safety impacts when spaces full, potential use of other unit and impact, queuing and impact on road, other local businesses.

Recommendation: Object Basis: The Parish Council had no objection to a convenience store in principle but they had the following objections and concerns: Lack of cycle and pedestrian access and provision, lack of safe crossing; overall parking at the site and impact on available space, confusion over allocation of 37 spaces; condition spaces for parking and turning; egress/ingress on 50mph road; temporary 40mph limit with 13,000 peak vehicles in one day on police data gathering box; road safety, queuing traffic, no protected lane for pulling off; hours of activity eg refuse collection; lighting should only illuminate site for residential amenity; access for larger volume vehicles who use the road; mention in planning statement of policy S4; lack of regular public transport, allocated work spaces for site as a whole.
