#### **Mass Hot Air Balloon Ascent**

Back in July we hosted a mass hot air balloon ascent in a bid to set a new world record for the number of balloons launched from an international airport. The event, which was run in conjunction with North Somerset Council and run by Exclusive Ballooning, launched over 30 hot air balloons from our runway to take part in this year's Exclusive Cup Competition as North Somerset hosts the UK's largest hot air balloon race.


### **Sustainability Initiatives**



#### Bristol Airport to be the first Net Zero UK airport

This summer, we announced that Bristol Airport will achieve being a carbon neutral airport four years ahead of schedule, reducing the time scale from 2025 to 2021. We have also set an ambitious target as we aim to achieve being a Net Zero airport operations by 2030, 20 years ahead of the Government target date. Our three key commitments to reach net zero by 2030 are to be a net zero airfield, with net zero buildings and operate a net zero fleet of vehicles.
