Thanks for your message. It's great to see that local enthusiasm and helpful to understand where communities see a need for additional charging provision – particularly where it can support local businesses and visitor footfall.

In terms of whether Avoch is likely to receive a public EV charging point: at the moment, I'm not able to confirm a specific future installation or a timeline.

There will be a significant number of new chargers added to the network within the next three years. But decisions about the locations are still to be finalised.

We'll be able to share more information with communities when we have it and I'll make sure your interest has been noted with the rest of our team.
