educational practice: The practical effort made over time by a professional practitioner to bring about learning with values of human flourishing.

Further explanation

From a cultural-historical perspective, a practice can be seen as arising in response to general demands of societal need. A practice can be conceptualized as a historically developed and conditioned tradition of action for addressing societally formed needs (Chaiklin, 2007).

From a Living-Educational Theory Research perspective, a practice is defined as the actions that influence learning with values of human flourishing.
