

**inquire / inquiry and enquire / enquiry:**

In British English, the words inquire / inquiry and enquire / enquiry are often used interchangeably; however, a slight distinction is beginning to develop between them. British writers now generally restrict *enquire / enquiry* to refer to the general sense of 'ask a question', whereas *inquire / inquiry* are used in contexts of formal investigations. For example,

- May I enquire as to the location of your bathroom?
- The police are conducting a full inquiry into how the crime was carried out.

Hence, Living Educational Theory Research studies are *inquiries*.
