6. Community Emergency Plan - Kinloch mtg 1st July

Following a useful meeting with SSE on 1 July it was agreed to submit a draft community emergency plan (CEP) by the deadline of 31st July. The Kinloch meeting to prepare the draft will discuss communication options in the event of a loss of service from BT and mobile operators during extreme weather events. Of particularly concern are the North Coast road communities. In parallel with the CEP a grant application will be made to SSE to cover the cost of

alternative communication options. and other worthwhile cost effective measures to make the community more resilient in advance of an extreme weather event.

7. Recycling

Once again the 1300 litre green bins adjacent to the toilets, the content of which goes to land-fill were found to be full of cardboard cartons which of course are recyclable and definitely should not go to landfill. This confusion as to what goes where happened on the same day that the bins had been emptied, thus preventing the disposal of legitimate landfill items.
