

 In 2022/23 we invested £886 million, on a like-for-like basis with 2021/22 - our biggest annual investment to date.




SW Public General



- We are investing more money each year in asset repair, refurbishment and replacement, but the age of our extensive water networks and the impacts of climate change present significant challenges
- The majority of recurring supply interruptions are associated with asbestos cement (AC) water mains – which currently represent around 12% of our water distribution mains
- Over time, Scotland's soft waters react with lime in the pipe wall, resulting in a loss of strength with ground movement in very dry periods presenting an additional risk
- We know we need to increase our rate of investment in water network renewal to meet this challenge

Short term work






- Initial plan to renew 120 metres of water main between Matheson Road and Stirling Drive
- Aim to deliver improvement to service for worst affected customers and avoid further need for repairs in the field

Longer term investment





- A capital project has been promoted to renew the remaining section of water main through Garve, both north and south of the field where the short term work is taking place
- A contractor is currently carrying out detailed design work which will form a basis for engagement with affected landowners, road and railway authorities
- Our aim is to start on site next year
