Overnight closures of the A9


Four overnight closures of the A9 north of Perth, between Luncarty junction and the A923 Dunkeld junction, north and southbound, are planned from 8:30pm to 6am on the following nights:

- Friday 22 February 2019
- Saturday 23 February 2019
- Sunday 24 February 2019
- Monday 25 February 2019

These closures are required to install a temporary safety barrier at various points along the 9.5km route to create a safety zone between the live traffic and construction workers.

Once installed, Balfour Beatty will begin the main construction works to dual the carriageway between Luncarty and Pass of Birnam as part of the Scottish Government's £3 billion A9 Dualling Programme.

This traffic management has been scheduled overnight to minimise the impact to road users following consultation with key stakeholders including Police Scotland, BEAR Scotland and Perth and Kinross

Closure dates

22, 23, 24, 25 February 2019 8.30pm to 6am

Contingency dates: 1, 2, 3, 4 March 2019 8.30pm to 6am

Council. All traffic should follow the signed diversion routes as outlined on the map – see reverse.

Preparatory works


In advance of the four overnight closures, traffic management will be required overnight to install narrow lanes and safety cameras to enforce a reduced speed limit of 40mph through the works area. Once installed, these restrictions will remain in place until completion of the project in Spring 2021. This traffic management will commence as follows:

- From Monday 4 February,
 7:30pm to 6:30am Luncarty to
 Bankfoot (southern extent of the project)
- From Monday 11 February, 7:30pm to 6:30am – Bankfoot to Gelly (northern extent of the project)
- These planned works are weather dependent and may require contingency dates.
