Quotes and Epitaphs from the Headstones at Dunblane Cathedral Graveyard

Transcribed in 2022.

Since 2020 I have taken part in several inspections of headstones, by Historic Environment Scotland, at Dunblane Cathedral. During these we noted that it was often difficult to read the inscriptions, partly due to the light and weather, but also because they are deteriorating.

Full inscriptions for all headstones, have now been transcribed, as far as is possible, and are available to view and search at Dunblane Museum. This includes the pre 1855 inscriptions, done by the Mitchells in the 1970s, which are now matched to the relevant headstone. They also have pictures of all the headstones, as well as any burial record and lair ownership information available.

Although epitaphs etc can be found in the post 1855 transcriptions, they are difficult to find and as they form an important part of any headstone, they are included here. Where available those from pre 1855 have also been added.

The headstone numbers provided, relate to the HES graveyard plan, a copy of which is on site at the cathedral, and available to look at in the Museum, this locates each headstone in the graveyard.

Many inscriptions are incomplete, unfortunately they are only going to get worse.

The more common; Rest in Peace, At Rest, Sacred to the Memory of and In Memoriam, are not included here.

The full inscription for headstone D178 has been completed from 'Monuments and Monumental Inscriptions in Scotland' Rev Charles Rogers Vol II 1872.

Many of the pictures used are by Leonard Bovill, who took photographs for Dunblane Museum 2006 – 2008. These were kindly loaned to HES by his wife, Heather, to help in the creation of records for headstone inspections. These images have proved to be very useful as they are more legible than recent photos and compare dramatically with the current appearance of many of the headstones.

The size of the picture does not relate to the actual size of the headstone.

Headstone D185 has an epitaph around the edge, but it is now too difficult to read and it isn't included here.

I haven't added pictures for all, as some headstones are broken in several pieces and the quality of some images wasn't good enough.

C2 doesn't fit my criteria for inclusion, but I've added it, as a post script, as so many visitors come to see it and again, the inscription is now very difficult to read. This, also, is one of Leonard's pictures and the inscription was done by the Mitchells.

There were undoubtedly many other epitaphs etc, which sadly now are completely gone.
