

## **Cold Ashby Parish Council Grant and Project funding; February 2026**

Cold Ashby Parish Council has received £5,790.53 from the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) to support the development of the local area by funding the demands that new building places on it. This has been allocated due to the development WND/2021/0015 (Land at Main Street/Stanford Road, Cold Ashby).

CIL funding should be used for capital projects that improve local infrastructure. Amongst other things, this may include:

- Enhancements to the village hall
- Improvements to recreation or sports fields
- Provision or upgrading of children's play areas
- Traffic calming measures
- Sustainable transport links
- Green infrastructure or environmental improvements.

The funding **cannot** be used for routine maintenance or operational costs, such as:

- Grass cutting
- Utility bills
- Routine repairs
- Staff salaries

The Parish Council must report the use of the funds to West Northants Council, and to residents on its website and noticeboard.

The Parish Council is inviting local organisations and residents to submit proposals and ideas for use of this money: organisations may wish to use the Council's grant application form available here: [CAPC Grant Application form](#). The Parish Council will also consider suggestions for projects that it can deliver directly itself.
