Action Point 8

Cemetery Pales & Chapel Lane – flooding near Mowbray and Limnau. Some jetting has already been done, should be added to work list for further work. Grips have been cut opposite the houses to allow surface water to drain rain from the road into the ditch.

This continues to be an issue. Regular flooding of the footway at the entrance to Chapel Lane and further west across the width of the road before entering the Green. Blocked (silted) drains and gips.

Action Point 9

Gapemouth Road, flooding under the tunnel on the bend towards Pirbright. A gulley is needed to drain the water, but Network Rail is asking for payment. A temp solution has been put in place.

Improvements previously made have resolved the worst issues but needs monitoring each year.

Action Point 10 – new Action

Sites 1 & 2 on Gole Road, widening of watercourse by landowner, causing potential flooding to School Lane at Causeway bridge. Installation of water supply by Thames Water and toilets on site with raw sewerage going into ditch ultimately leading to the Hoe at Fox Corner.
