- (1) should avoid any behaviour which might reasonably be seen as motivated by personal gain;
- (2) should never solicit a gift or hospitality;
- (3) may accept, but must register with the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of acceptance, any gift or hospitality of an estimated value between £25 and £50, subject always to the proviso that you exercise caution in accepting any gifts or hospitality regardless of value which are (or which you might reasonably believe to be) offered to you because you are a councillor; and
- (4) should never accept significant gifts or hospitality with an estimated value of more than £50 from any third party.]
