




## New Boilers

In October, new boilers were installed to replace the aging units that had been in operation for 25 years and had reached the end of their service life. The replacement was not only necessary for reliability and safety, but it is also expected to bring significant economic benefits through improved energy efficiency and reduced maintenance costs. With proper care and regular servicing, it's hoped that these new boilers will provide another 25 years of dependable performance.



## Replacement of all LPH's florescent lights.

 New LED lights were installed in the hall as a necessary upgrade following the government-mandated phase-out of fluorescent strip lighting. This change not only ensures compliance with updated regulations but also brings significant benefits in terms of energy efficiency and environmental impact. LED lighting consumes less electricity, has a longer lifespan, and requires less maintenance compared to traditional fluorescent fixtures, making it a more cost-effective and environmentally friendly choice for the long term.

 A new oven has been purchased as part of the initial phase of the kitchen refurbishment project. This marks the beginning of a broader effort to modernize and improve the kitchen facilities, aiming to enhance functionality, energy efficiency, and overall usability.
