
We are here for you as your church.

Alexander Barracks, Pirbright – Construction Works Update

The Defence Estate Optimisation (DEO) Army Programme, part of the Ministry of Defence, is continuing to work on plans for proposed construction works at Alexander Barracks, Pirbright. These will provide improved living, working and training buildings for personnel.

The team are working on the design and the masterplan, which is nearly ready for submission to the local authority for planning approval.

At the moment, much of the focus is on the enabling works which will be completed over the course of 2026. These are important to prepare for the rest of the project and include upgrading utilities and demolishing empty buildings whose occupants have already moved to other facilities as part of the barracks redevelopment.

December Christmas Eco Tip

Choose greener gift wrapping.

Swap shiny or glittery wrapping paper (which can't be recycled) for brown kraft paper, reusable fabric wraps, or even old Christmas sheet music or maps. Add natural touches like holly, twine, or a sprig of rosemary. It looks beautifully festive, reduces waste, and gives your gifts a charming, traditional Christmas feel.

December Gardening Tips

Tidy up fallen leaves from lawns, paths and beds to prevent rot and slippery surfaces. Compost them if dry. Protect tender plants with fleece, cloches, or straw. Bubble wrap pots (especially terracotta) to stop them cracking in frost. Check ties and supports after windy weather. Cut back dead perennials if you haven't already – or leave some seed heads for birds and winter interest.

Mulch borders with compost or well-rotted manure to protect roots and feed the soil. Plant bare-root roses, trees and shrubs while the ground isn't frozen – they'll establish well over winter. Harvest leeks, parsnips, sprouts and kale as needed – they'll sweeten after frost.

Plan next year's crops and rotate beds to avoid pests and disease build-up. Sow broad beans or garlic if soil conditions allow (use cloches or fleece for protection). Feed the birds! Fat balls, seed, and fresh water help them through winter. Prune apple and pear trees on dry days. Inspect tree stakes and ties – loosen or replace as needed. Pile up logs and leaves to make cosy homes for hedgehogs and insects
