	developed. PPC were keen to open a dialogue with the application and the history of the site and now it had
	PPC's preference would be a deferral of the application to allow such dialogue. If a deferred was rejected
	PPC would request that the application was refused due to the conditions currently being required which the
	parish council feel are too vague and unenforceable. PPC would wish to see conditions imposed to stipulate
	that all operations are carried out within the site in perpetuity. PPC would wish to see the other conditions
	currently being recommended, strengthened.
	PPC recognise that SF are a valuable business in the area and are willing to have further dialogue as to how
	they develop. PPC are registered to speak at the Planning Committee meeting and will circulate their
	prepared comments for consideration to the GBC Planning Committee meeting attendees. Cllr Watson will
	represent PPC at this meeting to be held on Wednesday 10 th August at the GBC offices in Guildford. Cllr
	Witham will also address the Planning Committee as Ward Councillor and will also be seeking to have the
