## Walks Around Pirbright Village

## Pirbright Walk No. 2


Route: Village Centre - School Lane - Gole Road - Basingstoke Canal - Curzon

Bridge - Gapemouth Road - Stanley Hill - Church Lane: 4½ Miles.

Option to extend to Deepcut Lock: 5½ miles. Start Point: Parish Shop. Map ref: SU945557.

Terrain: Easy, flat, no stiles.

- 1. Take the footpath beside the telephone box across the green to the car park. Continue along Avenue de Cagny, cross the A324 and turn L into School Lane. Pass the school and about 100 yards past Dawney's Rd on the R turn R on a signed footpath. At the end cross Gole Rd, go under the railway arch, keep L and turn L onto the Basingstoke Canal towpath for  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles.
- 2. At the brick built Curzon Bridge leave the towpath, turn L and go to para 3.
- 2A. For the longer walk pass under Curzon Bridge and continue for ½ mile to the signed Deepcut Lock. Just past here turn L at a fingerpost, then L again on a tarmac drive. Continue through a gate and over the railway, then turn L on a path running parallel to the railway. Back at the track over Curzon Bridge turn R.
- 3. Go under the railway arch and turn L on Gapemouth Rd. There is a good grass path running just inside the Camping Ground on the RH side. Where this ends after 600 yards at a locked gate rejoin Gapemouth Rd and turn R into Stanley Hill. On your R. is Furzehill, built by Henry Morton Stanley (who "found" Livingstone). At a 'T' junction turn L then R into Church Lane. Pass the church and continue back to the village centre.



## Pirbright Walk No. 3 (see map on next page)

Route: Village Centre – Brookwood Cemetery - Brookwood Station – Basingstoke Canal – A322 Bagshot Rd – Oaktree Rd – Sparvell Rd – Sheets Heath – Queens Rd – Basingstoke Canal: 4 Miles.

Option to extend via Stafford Lake: 4¾ miles. Start Point: Parish Shop Map Ref: SU945557.

Terrain: Generally flat and all weather. Only one bad wet patch in winter that is easily avoided. No stiles.

- 1. Follow para 1 of Walk No 4 and at the station entrance in Brookwood Cemetery go under the subway to the car park.
- 2. From Brookwood Station car park cross Connaught Rd and go ahead up Sheets Heath Lane to cross the canal bridge. Turn R along the towpath to the A322 and turn L along the road. After traffic lights fork L into Oak Tree Rd.
- 3. At a mini roundabout for the short walk turn L into Sparvell Rd. At the end continue on a fenced footpath, cross a footbridge and maintain direction when the path widens to a track, then to an unmade residential road. Ignore all side turnings to reach a gate leading to Sheets Heath. Continue across the heath and exit via a cattle grid. Turn immediately L on a footpath and go to para 4.
- 3A. For the longer walk go straight over the mini roundabout and on to the end of the road, where turn L round Grindstone Handle Corner. Keep ahead R at 2 forks. The path bends R through woods and at a fork go R along the LH edge of a large clearing towards a house. Turn L on Stafford Lake Rd and pass the Princess Christian Homes (vacated at the time of writing, 2005). At a signpost keep ahead on Bridleway No. 144 and continue past a wooden gate into woods. At a fork keep ahead R. Pass houses and turn L on a road. Bear R to pass a metal barrier and in a few yards fork L following a line of telegraph poles. After 100 yards fork L on a footpath and at a fork go L to a waymark post. At the next waymarked 'T' junction turn L. (If the way ahead here is impassable due to mud turn R instead as far as Queens Rd, where turn L down to the canal bridge.) Otherwise cross a footbridge and go ahead through woods soon with a fence on the L to reach a tarmac road with a cattle grid to your L. Cross over to a footpath.
- 4. Go downhill to Queens Rd and turn L to the canal bridge, where turn L along the towpath back to the bridge and retrace your steps to the station. Turn L under the subway and follow para 2 of Walk No. 4 back to the village centre.

## Walk No. 4

Route: Village Centre – Dawney's Hill – Brookwood Cemetery – Brookwood Station – St Edward's Chapel – Chapel Lane: 23/4 miles.

Start Point: Parish Shop. Map ref: SU945557. Terrain: Good, flat, all weather, no stiles.

1. Take the footpath next to the telephone box. At the car park turn L along Avenue de Cagny and at the end turn R and R again into The Gardens. Past 'Holly Grange' take the footpath on the L. Go over a drive and take the LH path into woods. At a fork go R then turn R on the tarmac drive into Brookwood Military Cemetery. The gates are open between 9am and 7.30pm daily. Gates close at 'dusk' if earlier than 7.30pm. At a 'T' junction turn R and at the next 'T' junction turn L, soon passing the American, Czech and Polish sections. Go through a gate into the civilian cemetery and in about 150 yards turn L and make your way up across the grass towards the entrance to Brookwood Station.

2. Turn R on the cemetery road in front of the station and at a 'T' junction turn L along Long Ave., then R on Railway Ave., formerly a cemetery railway line. Continue across Cemetery Pales into the southern half of the cemetery. Proceed along St Cyprian's Ave. Reach St Edward's Orthodox Chapel and turn R along St Chad's Ave. Pass 3 turnings on the L, then turn L down St Mark's Ave. This long path leads out of the cemetery onto Pirbright Common. At a path junction on the common take the central path and at a crossing path turn R. Reach Chapel Lane, where turn R back to the village centre.
