

Minutes of an Extraordinary Meeting of the Council held at 7.30pm on Thursday 4th January 2018

Those present: Councillor Trevelyan, Chairman; Councillors Boylan, Fitzpatrick, Wilson and Bushby; County Councillor Jones; one member of the public and Mr W Browne-Swinburne.

- 1. Apologies for absence from Councillor Sharp and C Miller (Clerk)
- Planning Matters Outline application (some matters reserved) including access and layout for the erection of 17 2. dwellings, Land North West of Stannerton House, North Side, Stamfordham, Northumberland

The applicant (Mr W Browne-Swinburne) outlined the proposals and answered various questions and after a time he left the meeting.

It was decided to put forward the Council's objections and comments as below:

- 1. The proposed site is outside the village settlement boundary of Stamfordham as defined in the Council's Local Plan Core Strategy document
- 2. The proposed development will have a significant negative visual impact on the western approach to the village
- 3. The proposed entrance is considered to be dangerous
- 4. Car parking should be adjacent to the bungalows
- 5. The figures quoted in the supporting Transport Statement for traffic movements of 7 or 8 at peak hours appear to be totally unrealistic as there will probably be two cars per dwelling and there is very limited bus service
- 6. No need for allotments
- 7. There should be no development behind the existing houses


