





- 3. Your scarecrow should be named, with that name being clearly displayed for identification purposes.
- 4. Displayed with your scarecrow should be the Date and Time of the Fayre (Stamfordham Village Fayre, 27th August 2017 1-4pm) If not displayed scarecrow will be disqualified.
- 5. Scarecrows should be registered and in place by 16th August no sooner please and taken down at the end of the day of the Fayre.
