### **Your Questions Answered**

**Q.** Over the last few week I have noticed little, yellow wheelie bins in Stamfordham and Matfen and some plastic boxes in Great Whittington. What are they?

A. They are collection points for donations of food and grocery items to help with the project.

Q. What is the Upper Pont Community Hub?

**A.** At this unusual time of furlough, job loss etc. many in our community are facing unprecedented difficulties financially, psychologically and spiritually. The project is an attempt for those more fortunate to help members of our community facing these problems.

Q. How can I help?

**A.** If you are in a position to do so by donating anything from a single item of food or grocery to a few you can help maintain a food bank to be distributed as required.

Q. What sort of things are needed?

**A.** This varies from time to time, from baked beans, canned soups, chopped tomatoes, pasta and rice which help make a meal to toiletries and household cleaning materials, they are all much appreciated. In fact anything you might expect to find in the weekly shop.

Q. Is there anything you are currently short of?

A. Our wish list currently includes breakfast cereals, tinned meats, canned vegetables (such as potatoes and carrots), tinned fruit and pasta sauces. Also soap, shampoo and cleaning materials.

**Q.** Is there any other way I can help?

**A.** Yes. By making a donation, either single or regular. If your donation qualifies for Gift Aid, please contact Revd Rachel. The funds can then be used to purchase special items or ones in short supply. See details below:


