From: Dog Warden, Northumberland County Council

You must always keep your dog on a lead when visiting memorial grounds, cemeteries or gardens of remembrance anywhere in Northumberland and on any land classified as an 'A' or 'B' road ,together with adjoining verges etc.

It is an offence not to put and keep your dog on a lead at any time, in any public place if a council official asks you to do so in the interest of public safety.

Leads should be no more than 1.5m in length. You must immediately pick up after your dog if it fouls.

It is an offence to allow your dog to foul land without immediately picking up. This applies to any land in Northumberland which is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to access (with or without payment).

The fixed notice penalty for any offence committed against the Northumberland County Council (Dog Control) Public Spaces Protection Order is £100 (£80 if paid within my 7 days), to be paid in 14 days. If it isn't paid the Council would normally prosecute the offender in a magistrates' court which could result in





"It's okay... he's friendly!"

No. It's not okay. If you see a dog on a leash - call your dog away.

If your off-lead dog doesn't have good enough recall to be called away from an on-leash dog - don't let them off and take the time to train them.

Please think about the other dogs, not just your own.

Dogs can be on-leash for all sorts of reasons, not just because they are fearful of other dogs. Some reasons to recall your dog away:

- recovering from surgery
- elderly / sick
- restricted exercise
- poor recall
- new rescue dog young puppy

Protect your dog: dogs who have poor recall can get into all sorts of trouble. If your dog is bitten (even just once) this could lead to your own dog becoming fearful.

The mobile library will not operate its normal schedule. All other libraries will remain closed. Fines on overdue books are currently suspended.

Customers can contact libraries offering a select and collect service by filling in an <u>online form</u> or by calling the <u>library telephone number</u>.

Cllr Jeff Watson, cabinet member for the library service said: "We know that many children are currently home-schooling and therefore may not have access to their normal school library, where they would be able to read a variety of books.

"Parents and children may be getting fed up with their book choices at home, so the wide selection available on the digital library and via the Select and Collect service, is a great way to continue your child's reading journey through this difficult time."
