

## The Cyclone Festival of Cycling ......

.....is looking forward to making a return to its spiritual home, the village of Stamfordham, in early July. If the Government's plans to remove Coronavirus restrictions go to schedule, the Festival will once again bring cyclists of all ages and abilities back to the beautiful Northumberland countryside and its distinctive villages and nowhere is more synonymous with the festival than Stamfordham.

On Saturday 3 July, the village hall will be the focus of attention, with riders in the Cyclone's Challenge Rides, homing in on the food and drink that will be available for them. With four different routes (all passing through the village in their latter stages) the Challenge Rides bring in thousands of riders of all abilities, many of them raising money for charity. Stamfordham is their last official "feed" of the day and many will linger to enjoy the huge range of cakes, teas, sandwiches and snacks that the village hall volunteers put on.

This wonderful coming-together of hungry and thirsty riders and the matchless home baking skills of Stamfordham brings in a lot of welcome funding to the village hall.

Stamfordham will be at the hub of the action on the Sunday, 4<sup>th</sup> July, when it is the host village for the women's Curlew Cup and men's Beaumont Trophy races. Both events are part of British Cycling's national series and will feature professional riders who have competed at the highest level. Previous winners include Olympic medallists Bradley Wiggins and all-time Paralympic great, Sarah Storey.

The races start on the road in the village centre and take in multiple laps of a anti-clockwise loop to the North of the village. The village hall will again be an important component in the day's activities, acting as the HQ for the races and once again putting out food and drink all day long for hungry officials, riders and spectators.

Those spectators also fan out through the village and into the surrounding countryside, visiting pubs and shops and, in many cases, sampling the ice cream cart that is always parked at the top of the Ryals climb, a few miles up the road.

Cyclone organiser, Peter Harrison, is looking forward to July: "Having fallen victim to the pandemic in 2020, we have been determined to bring the Cyclone Festival of Cycling back in 2021. We have always been incredibly grateful for the support of the people of Stamfordham who allow us to take over their village for a weekend every year. This time we're looking forward to celebrating a return to normality with our many friends in the village and we'll be encouraging all our riders and spectators to come into the village and enjoy the hospitality its famous for!"

## Hadrian's Wall to celebrate 1900th anniversary with year-long festival

Hadrian's Wall will celebrate its 1900th anniversary in 2022 with a year-long festival of events and activities.

Hadrian's Wall 1900 will mark the commencement of the building of Hadrian's Wall. A packed programme of events and activities will take place throughout 2022 including exhibitions, lectures and film screenings. There will be opportunities to take part in workshops, walks and creative projects; and experience the stunning landscape through creative installations and events.

The year-long festival, being co-ordinated by Hadrian's Wall Partnership in collaboration with local people and organisations, will bring communities and visitors closer to the people that have lived and worked along the Wall from pre-Roman times to the present day.

Individuals, groups, venues and organisations along the length of the World Heritage UNESCO site are now being invited to plan their own celebration to be included in the Hadrian's Wall 1900 programme.

Inclusion in the festival is open to anyone that wishes to explore and demonstrate what Hadrian's Wall means to them. Events and activities will then be promoted as part of the Festival through a local and national marketing and PR campaign.

Lady Jane Gibson, Chair of Hadrian's Wall Partnership, said: "We are thrilled to be announcing our yearlong festival to commemorate Hadrian arriving in northern Britain to oversee the construction of his Wall. 2022 will be a year of anniversaries but no other festival will be celebrating 1900 years of continuous history of a place and its people. The communities living around the Wall now have one of the world's most famous landmarks in their fields, villages, towns and cities and we want everyone to be involved in celebrating not just the history under their feet but the international importance of World Heritage today. From Hadrian's birthday on 24th January to Saturnalia on 23rd December, 2022 will be the year of Northern Britain."

Cllr Glen Sanderson, Leader of Northumberland County Council, said: "Hadrian's Wall 1900 is set to be an exciting programme with our communities living along the wall at the heart of the activities. This is an opportunity for residents and groups to come together and celebrate how the Wall has shaped our great county and we encourage all those communities to get involved. As well as this event we also have the Lindisfarne Gospels returning to the region next year, so 2022 is a real opportunity for Northumberland to further raise its profile as a visitor destination of choice."

Ideas do not need to be fully formed at this stage. Organisers will be responsible for the overall delivery of their events and activities including funding, audience management and health and safety, and additional marketing.

During the current crisis we who live in and around Stamfordham have been blessed by the opportunity to walk locally and avoid the claustrophobia that many living in more restricted places must feel.

For more than three decades I have run, then jogged, then walked, then ambled down Mill Lane with a variety of animals and people - it was a favourite walk. Today it is sadly to be avoided because, I presume as a consequence of the establishment of the strangely named La Luna Farm, it has become a frequently used thoroughfare for a variety of vehicles. The frequent use has caused significant damage to the lane and what was once a delight is a depressing shadow of its former self. We are being deprived of a village asset we can ill afford to lose.

I am confident the lane can be reclassified as a bridleway by the County Council. I would like to encourage us all to urge the Parish Council, and thereafter the County Council, to take the necessary steps to protect our environment.




