
Please note the following rules when visiting the Post Office.

Hello, I'm Dharma, a Yoga & Mindfulness Teacher who has just moved to Wallridge. I'm delighted to run two taster sessions – one for Mindfulness and one for Yoga – at Stamfordham Village Hall on Tuesday 17th August.

Each class will be perfect for anyone over 18 who wants to give Yoga or Mindfulness a try for the first time or returners wanting to get back to a regular class post-lockdown. They will be offered in a Covid-secure environment, with plenty of spacing and ventilation, following all Government guidelines as well as guidelines by each venue.

I am registered with and fully insured through Yoga Alliance Professionals.

WHAT IS YOGA? WHAT IS MINDFULNESS?

The NHS website describes Yoga as 'an ancient form of exercise that focuses on strength, flexibility and breathing to boost physical and mental wellbeing.' (<u>A guide to yoga - NHS (www.nhs.uk</u>)) The Yoga I teach is a gentle and mindful practice involving both 'yin' style asanas (where you hold a posture for a few breaths) and kriyas (where you move from one posture to another). Each session includes a guided meditation and relaxation to ensure you leave feeling refreshed and rejuvenated.

Mindfulness is described by the NHS website as 'paying more attention to the present moment – to your own thoughts and feelings, and to the world around you.' (<u>Mindfulness - NHS (www.nhs.uk</u>)) Like Yoga it's a wonderful way to bring a sense of balance and calm into our lives, but as it isn't a physical practice per se, it is more accessible and can be practised by just about anyone - you can practise mindfulness in a chair or even lying down.

WHAT DO PARTICIPANTS NEED TO BRING?

All you need is a yoga mat (optional for the mindfulness taster), a bottle of water and a blanket to keep nice and warm during relaxation.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

£8 for one of the taster sessions/ £10 for both.


