For the first time since 1988, Stamfordham Cricket Club are champions of the West Tyne League. The title was sealed with a comfortable 10-wicket win over neighbours Belsay CC in early September.

This is just the fifth time, since the club was originally founded in 1878, that such a feat has been achieved.

The win at Belsay capped an incredible season, with the team winning 15 of their 22 games & finishing 25 points clear of reigning champions Haydon Bridge CC.

During the season, club stalwart Ian Donkin topped the league batting charts with a massive 602 runs & Nicho-Ias Schofield, a soldier based at Albemarle Barracks, took 38 wickets, more than anyone else in the division.

The title seals a huge turn in fortunes for the club. Following near extinction in 2014, the club bucked the trend of local sport, became the catalysts behind the new pavilion & have transformed themselves into one of the fastest growing and ambitious sports clubs in Northumberland. With a thriving youth section, an excellent social scene and the superb facility, success on the field was the only thing missing in recent years.
