

### What's your talent?

The church of St Mary the Virgin sits in the heart of the west end of the village of Stamfordham and has been an important focus for both significant life events and village events for many hundreds of years. The current building dates, in parts, from Saxon times with many additions and changes over the years, and like all buildings, needs continuous care and maintenance to meet the needs of the people. In the last year, thanks to significant grants, the east windows underwent a refurbishment and the chancel has a new roof. Keeping the building going takes more than major building works, just as running your home, you keep up with the cleaning, laundry and cooking and perhaps gardening to run your household, the church relies on volunteers to ensure it runs smoothly.

Many skills are needed to do this from dusting and changing light bulbs, cutting the grass and weeding, ordering oil and arranging safety checks, to filling in grant applications in addition to the preparation to deliver worship.

Our community has many skills within it and many already share their skills in the church and its grounds. What skill do you have that you can share, to ensure that the church continues in your community? Without you, there is always the risk that it becomes unviable to remain open each day, as it does now, that the churchyard becomes overgrown and neglected and that services and ceremonies can no longer take place. Your church depends on you. What talent can you bring to support the church? As the story goes, talent doesn't grow by being buried, but by being used.




