

#### Stamfordham Parish Neighbourhood Plan

Stamfordham Parish Council has started the process of developing a Neighbourhood Plan for the parish. This includes the village as well as Dalton, Eachwick, Harlow Hill and The Heugh as well as outlying areas.

The purpose of the plan is to provide some guidance on how we want to see the parish change and develop over the next few years. The plan, once finalised, would provide local policy guidance to County Council planning officers when considering planning applications in the parish. We can decide on what elements we include and what we don't within the constraints of the plan's scope.

We have decided to break the process down into three main areas:

- 1. Housing (If and where new housing might be built, type and style of that housing etc.)
- 2. Heritage (Historic Buildings and sites, conservation areas, etc)
- 3. Environment (renewable energy, nature, green space etc.)

#### How can you get involved?

It is important that parishioners get involved in the process as this is a plan that will impact on the future of the parish. We will be providing a number of drop in opportunities to talk about matters that concern you, please watch out for details. The three main topic areas will also be holding a series of meetings to help develop proposed policies, if you would like to join one or more of these please get in touch. We are particularly keen to hear from you if you live in the more outlying parts of the parish. You do not have to commit to attending many meetings, you would be very welcome to drop in and out if you wish.

We would also welcome anyone wanting to join the steering group – coordinating the work of the topic groups and meeting approximately every 2 months.

Ultimately a neighbourhood plan has to have the support of the community and will be the subject of a local referendum. It is not a Parish Council plan it is a plan for the whole parish.

#### Stamfordham Meadows

The wetlands to the west of the village, known as Stamfordham Meadows, is part of the flood plain of the River Pont. The land floods quickly as water levels rise but also drain off fast. This has the effect that water levels peak in the river quickly after heavy rain. If those wetlands held water longer it could help reduce the effects of flooding in the village and downstream.

There is an opportunity to look at developing these wetlands as a community nature reserve and get involved in some of the survey work being carried out by the Environment Agency to assess the opportunities for these wetlands to help protect against flooding.

Some of the ideas, over and above better wetland creation, that are being considered include:

- 1. New access including wildlife watching points
- 2. Woodland planting including a community orchard
- 3. Restored hedgerows
- 4. Educational opportunities

However, there may be other opportunities for wildlife and for the community that could be considered.




