Greening Up is in progress with the re-wilding of the large grass verge at Bridge End which includes the planting of the second set of ten NCC (Natures Harvest) Free Trees. More sites will be identified throughout the parish.

Compiling a **Neighbourhood Plan** is to be considered and carried forward.

Ten new **Litter Bins** are awaiting their artwork and installation around the village. Hopefully our visitors will be as keen to use them as our residents.

Ongoing consideration is being given on how to engage the outlying areas of the parish and how to make them more inclusive and better connected. Promoting the Communicator to all residents and how to receive it digitally has been attempted.

The Communicator is working well keeping everyone up to date with events and advertising. Thank you to the editor.

All routine matters have been addressed and thanks are due to our County Councillor for support and guidance when needed as well as keeping us up to date with a more general view of what is happening at County level.
