PLANNING APPLICATIONS UPDATE

The Parish Council met this week to discuss the two recent local planning applications that we have been notified:

NE/22/00698/OUT in respect to additional warehousing off the A605 near Thrapston and Titchmarsh. Comments were due in by 1 July. The Council agreed to submit a similar letter of objection to the adjacent site

NE/22/00665/FUL in respect to demolition of an existing conservatory and erection of a ground floor rear extension, and loft conversion with proposed front and rear dormers at Craigmarr, Main Street. The Parish Council submitted a number of recommendations and comments.



Officers at Northamptonshire Police are again encouraging members of the public to be aware of courier fraud following fresh reports in the county.
